

**RURAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE
(Cap. 132)**

**KUALA PENYU DISTRICT COUNCIL
(PIG CONTROL) BY-LAWS 1961
(G.N.S 123 of 1961)**

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by paragraph (7) of subsection (1) of section 15 of the Rural Government Ordinance, and all other powers thereunto it enabling, the Kuala Penyu District Council has made the following by-laws:

Citation and application.

1. These by-laws may be cited as the Kuala Penyu District Council (Pig Control) By-laws 1961 and shall apply throughout the local area.

Pigsty to be approved by Council.

2. All persons whose pigs are within one mile of any public road, jeep track or bridle-path shall keep such pigs in a pigsty of a type to be approved by the District Council.

Penalty.

3. Any person failing to comply with these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of one hundred ringgit for the first offence and two hundred ringgit for the second or any subsequent offence.

Revocation.

4. The Pig Control (Kuala Penyu and Membakut Areas) By-laws published as *Gazette* Notification No. S 38 of 1956, in so far as they apply to the Kuala Penyu District, is revoked.
