

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ORDINANCE 1961
(No. 11 Of 1961)

SANDAKAN MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
(DEALING IN SCRAP) BY-LAWS 1970
(G.N.L 46 of 1969)

In exercise of the powers conferred upon it by section 50 of the Local Government Ordinance 1961, the Sandakan Town Board has made the following by-laws:

1. Title and commencement.

These by-laws may be cited as the Sandakan Municipal Council (Dealing in Scrap) By-laws 1970 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of January 1970.

2. Interpretation.

In these By-laws, "dealing in scrap" means the buying of scrap materials of whatever kind except rubber scrap.

3. Licence for dealing in scrap.

No person may deal in scrap except in accordance with a licence granted by the Council.

4. Application for licence.

An application for a licence shall be in writing and shall state the age of the applicant, the proposed place of business and the kind of scrap in which he proposes to deal.

5. Grant of licence.

The Council may, in its absolute discretion, grant or refuse a licence, or grant a licence subject to such conditions as it thinks fit. Such licence shall be in the form of the Schedule to these By-laws.

6. Duration of licence.

Every licence shall, subject to the provisions of these By-laws, expire on the 31st day of December of the year in which it is granted.

7. Fee [Mod. Act 160; am. G.N.L 22/76].

The annual fee for a licence shall be sixty ringgit:

Provided that any licence granted after the 31st day of January of each year the fee shall be two ringgit per month or part thereof.

8. Register of purchases.

- (1) Every person licensed to deal in scrap shall maintain a register of purchases made by him.
- (2) Such register shall record the name and address of the person from whom scrap is purchased, the kind of scrap, the quantity and price paid.
- (3) Such register shall be open to inspection by any officer of the Council at any time during business hours.

9. Inspection of scrap.

No scrap in respect of which the Council has notified its intention to inspect shall be removed from the licensee's premises or be treated or otherwise disposed of.

10. Penalty [Mod. Act 160].

Any person contravening any of the provisions of these By-laws shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable to a fine of five hundred ringgit.

11. Cancellation of licence.

The Council may cancel or suspend any licence if the licensee or any assistant of the licensee is convicted of any offence under these By-laws.
